2014 ANDOLSEN VINEYARD CABERNET SAUVIGNON *Dry Creek Valley | Sonoma County*

VINEYARD: Andolsen | 10 acres | Planted 1999

VARIETAL: 95% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Cabernet Franc, 1% Petit Verdot

HARVEST: October, 2014

COOPERAGE: Aged 18 months in new and used French oak barrels.

ALC: 14.8%

CASES PRODUCED: 916

WINEMAKER NOTES

We buy these grapes from Dr. Andolsen, our long-time friend and family doctor. The steep, terraced vineyard is located in Dry Creek's western foothills. This Cabernet is herbaceous and earthy as we have come to expect from this vineyard, but is more fruit forward than previous vintages. Black currant, plum, and white peppercorn take over on the nose while cedar, earth and unmistakable cassis dance on the palate, leaving a long finish.
